

TOWN OF GALE REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
March 10, 2026

The regular board meeting for the Town of Gale was held on February 16, 2026 at 7:30 p.m. Town board members that were present were Paul Halderson, Sharon Spahr, Kevin Duch, Mike Oslie, Matt Andersen and Sue Henderson the Clerk-Treasurer was also present. Others present were Kevin Evenson, Randy Mickelson, Jason Lee, Jim and Jamie Stetzer.

Paul Halderson called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. The open meeting law requirements had been met by posting and publication.

Matt Andersen made a motion to approve the minutes as printed. Kevin Duch seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Under specific matters for discussion which was agenda item four:

Grant Road is eligible for the LRIP Program. The hill portion will need to be ground and paved and the crushed rock portion will need to be paved. A Class 2 notice will need to be placed in the paper. Mike Oslie made a motion to approve the Grant Road LRIP project. Matt Andersen seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Under citizen appearances there were none.

Under the machinery report it was reported that the contractor and the insurance company are working together on the salt shed numbers. More to report next month on if it will be fixed or replaced.

For the road report it was reported that they have been plowing, sanding and trimming trees. The road bans are currently on. There was discussion on the upcoming widening of Irvine Lane. Kevin Evenson will be off work this summer due to shoulder surgery and John Marsh will help out as needed.

Under correspondence there was none.

A Fire Board meeting update was given. The upstairs of the station is being remolded. The dept is also looking at an alternative fundraiser. There is consideration to trade the emergency management trailer in on a utv trailer.

A report was given on the STCSWC meeting. The inventory and pricing handout was discussed. The upcoming meeting with Hilltopper to go over the yearly numbers will be scheduled. The bobcat at the recycling center was repaired.

The WTA district meeting update was given. There was Board of Review Training as part of the program. Emergency Management was discussed along with Transportation funding. A resolution to present to the Governor for road aid money was discussed.
